## Order

To reduce out of pocket expenses and compensate for wage loss and transport cost with ultimate objective to reduce HIV-related morbidity and mortality of the HIV infected and HIV exposed babies by facilitating better ART adherence (of the PLHIVs) and/or optimization of Nevirapine Prophylaxis coverage as well as timely HIV testing (of HIV exposed babies), a state specific scheme of monetary support (fixed) to the People Living with HIV/AIDS (PLHIV) and on ART has been rolled out and implemented across the state vide this OM Nos. ACS/3D-01-2015/66 dated 16.04.15 and ACS/3D-01-2015/243 dated 20.05.15 respectively.

To ensure rapid disbursement of fund as well as to facilitate in reaching out maximum number of eligible beneficiaries (both ANC and non-ANC clients) with the benefit of the ' **Financial Grant to the PLHIVs Scheme** ', it is now being decentralized. Henceforth, the grant-in-aid will be released from SACS to all ART Centres/FI-ART Centres and from there it will be further disbursed directly to the eligible beneficiaries through e-transfer.

The Revised Operational Framework is enclosed herewith. However, the rest of the Scheme guidelines will remain unaltered.

This will take with immediate effect.

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
