ORDER

Under the National AIDS Control Programme (NACP), Targeted Intervention - which is a flagship prevention programme of National AIDS Control Organisation (NACO) is being implemented through NGO/CBO/Network partners for different typologies of hard-to-reach populations who are at high risk and/or vulnerable to HIV/AIDS.

We are aware that in global solidarity to end AIDS epidemic as a public health threat globally by 2030 in line with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDG), India is committed to achieve the global HIV treatment target of 95:95:95 by 2024 and has already embarked upon a Fast-Track approach w.r.t. AIDS response.

In order to achieve the abovementioned global targets, TI Revamping Strategy has been opted by NACO, Ministry of H&FW, Govt. of India in order to provide comprehensive prevention, testing, treatment package to vulnerable population. To achieve the first 95 (i.e., atleast 95% of all the estimated PLHIV will know their seropositive status by 2024) as part of the aforesaid strategy, Community-based Screening for HIV through Targeted Intervention (TI) in urban and Link Worker Scheme (LWS) in rural areas for all (both registered ones and those outside the catchment area) Key populations (KPs)/HRGs has already been rolled out across the state under the Phase-IV of the National AIDS Control Programme and being continuing in Phase-V (NACP-V).

In order to ensure proper treatment and disposal of the Bio-Medical Waste generated out of the Community Based Screening at TI/LWS/ELM level following The Bio-Medical Waste Management (Amendment) Rules, 2019 issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Govt. of India dated 19th Feb., 2019, further to this OM No. ACS/1N-04-2017/410 dated 29.11.2020, the **administrative authorities of the concerned public health facilities are hereby requested to kindly extend their cooperation in term of allowing the nearby TI/LWS-implementing partners for bio-medical waste disposal of the into their existing system.**

List of TI/LWS-implementing partners and the tagged public health facilities is enclosed herewith (Ref : Annexure).

The TI/LWS-implementing agencies will be responsible for segregation of waste (at the source), storage (temporary with necessary measures adhering to the norms), transportation and handover of the bio-medical waste generated out of the community based screening and/or NSEP to the tagged hospital/s at a regular interval.

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
