The forth fortnightly coordination meeting of TI, STI, CST and ICTC was held on 23.04.2015 at 2:30 p.m. at the WBSAP&CS' Conference Room, Swasthya Bhawan, Kolkata-91. The same was convened by Dr.D.N.Goswami, Joint Director (TI) and the Chief Coordinator of TI, STI & CST Divisions, WBSAP&CS. The Dy.Secretary in Dept.of H&FW, Govt.of West Bengal and Dy.Project Director, WBSAP&CS chaired the said meeting.

The meeting begun with sharing/recapitulating the resolutions of the 3rd fortnightly meeting by the Chief Coordinator that was held on 27.02.15 and acceptance of the same by the house. After detailed discussion on different agenda items, the following resolutions were adopted.

- A committee for condemnation of already expired STI/ARV drugs needs to be formed.
- 6 DAPCUs out of total 8 in the state found to be poor performing in terms of SIMS reporting, timely report return, logistics/supply chain management, coordination issues. Non-DAPCU districts will be tagged with the existing DAPCU districts to ensure better monitoring as well as implementation of the programme.

- EOI for LWS implementing agency for the state/district to be floated by TI Division, WBSAP&CS in May, 2015.
- Requisitioned to be re-submitted by the CST Division, WBSAP&CS of bare requisite nursing staff for different facilities under NACP-IV to be provided from the state government pool of the same.
- Cost estimate for necessary civil and electrical works by PWD for minor refurbishment of new DSRCs to be obtained. The health facilities who have intimated about already prepared site for proposed DSRC to be prioritized. The same procedure to be followed for establishment of new LACs at DH/SDH.
- Two LACs out of total targeted four at Mirik BPHC, Darjeeling and Jangipur SDH, Murshidabad got operational since April, 2015 as shared by JD (CST), WBSAP&CS. Out of the remaining two, LAC at Basirhat DH, Basirhat Health District will start functioning in May, 2015. The one at Kalyani MC&H, Nadia will get operational shortly and is being followed up by concerned division.
- Three targeted Facility-Integrated ART Centres at BSMC&H, Bankura, Tamluk DH, Purba Midnapore, and Krishnanagar DH, Nadia and one ART at Barasat DH, 24 Parganas (N) will be operational from 1st May, 2015 as intimated by JD (CST), WBSAP&CS.
- Out of targeted six OST Centres at government health facilities, the one at CNMC&H, Kolkata has already started functioning since April, 2015. The hand over process by the NGO so far implementing OST programme for IDUs was done to Darjeeling DH, Darjeeling on the very date of the fortnightly meeting. The hand over process of OSTC at NBMC&H, Darjeeling is being under process. The rest ones i.e., OSTCs at Kalimpong SDH, Kurseong SDH and Mirik BPHC will get operational from 1st May, 2015 as intimated by JD (TI), WBSAP&CS.
- As reported by the M & E division, WBSAP&CS the data in relation to STI and TI and TI and ICTC are already available in the SIMS reporting which showed that there was > 25% increase in clinic footfall in the STI clinic in the last quarter in comparison to previous quarter. TI and ICTC linkage though increased still it is below the expected level. In relation to ICTC-ART linkage, as the centrewise data is not available with SIMS, it is difficult to pinpoint the areas from where maximum numbers of linkage is occurring. The matter is discussed with JD (CST) and it is suggested that the issues need to be taken up during the monthly ART, CSC, ICTC & TI coordination meeting. A circular need to be issued from the concerned division in this regard.

- Following the correspondence received from PO (Counseling), NACO regarding the Nodal Officer-In-Charge for Integrated Trainings of Counsellors for WBSAP&CS, the matter may be reconsidered by the competent authority.
- A demonstration of the new webportal of WBSAP&CS that was under process of finalization was given by Mr. Soumya Mondal, AD (M&E & ICTC), WBSAP&CS and feedbacks requested for improvisation of the same.

The next fortnightly coordination meeting has been scheduled on 08.05.15.

The meeting was concluded with vote of thanks to and from the Chair.
