#### ORDER

In order to ensure better linkage between stand alone ICTC and ART centres, National AIDS Control Organization has come up with a software called PALS i.e. PLHIV ART Linkage Software where ICTCs are to enter the data of every positive client detected from their facility (General as well as Pregnant) and ART centres are to complete the ART intervention related information. This is an online application and software may be accessed from desktop/Laptop and android devices. Therefore all of you are hereby directed to start data entry immediately for all the positive clients detected after 1/10/16 (and also known positive cases coming to you with new pregnancy after 1/10/16). ART centres will be able to fill ART information after ICTC can fill up the data. Therefore data entry at ICT level should be done on urgent basis following detection. Necessary sensitization has already been done during review meetings. A guideline for integrated PALS is annexed herewith for better understanding. The Centre wise User ID, password (to be changed by the facilities), Demonstration module, data definition, User manuals will be shared with the facilities by the respective divisions.

Therefore all of have to implement the program soon after the order is issued.

# PLHIV - ART Linkage system (PALS) www.plhiv-naco.com

## Pre-requisites:

#### Browser:

Internet Explorer (IE)10 or above with no add-ons; EDGE with no add-ons; Chrome50 with no add-ons and Mozilla latest version (Mozilla may give some security alerts)

## Internet band width:

Minimum of 512 kbps but preferred is 1 mbps or 2 mbps

#### Note:

- As PALS website is SSL enabled; it is advised to install Antivirus and should be configured for allowing SSL connections or certificate identification
- It is advised to use latest versions of windows operating system; if not able to use latest version of windows operating system please update your browsers with latest versions as mentioned above to access the PALS system.

# Step by Step login process for ICTC

- Type the URL www.plhiv-naco.comin Address bar of internet browser and click Go button or press enter key.
- Enter the User ID, Password given by SACS and enter captcha (numbers shown in right side box) click on "Login" Button.
- System will display in right side General Information of the particular login in various categories, i.e it will display login details i.e ICTC, / ART name District and state name.
  - Left side you will find menu:

    - Change Password;
    - 6. Logout.
  - Right side you will find four boxes i.e.,

## Searching/ updating existing record: Click on the Add Search Menu

General Client / Pregnant Women / Infant babies. By default, system will display dash board. If you click on ART linkages view details, then system will display the list of patients registered in ART based on login.

- o Dashboard: Will allow user to get customized dashboard based on the selection.

    - If you select any of the above option system will allow user to search on different criteria with PID number, name of the Patient, Phone no and Aadhaar Number or demographic details of the Patientand financial year wise, if you enter any search criteria then system will display the patient details matching with search criteria across the country.

**Searching/ updating existing record (Linking to ART):** Click on the **ART Search Menu** and select sub any menu i.e.
